In the event of a fire, finding the fire hydrant closest to your home is critical for firefighters. We are encouraging Neighborhoods to adopt a fire hydrant(s) near their homes. This will ensure hydrants are visible and accessible, which will greatly speed the response time getting the water needed for the emergency. Adopting a fire hydrant can be made simple, and can be part of your summer and winter activities (mowing, gardening, tree trimming, snow removal). Donating a little part of your time will help ensure your neighborhood is a little bit safer in the event of a fire.

Adopt a Fire Hydrant Activities

Summer

- Mow and trim grass/weeds around regularly (clear a 3-foot circle).
- Keep vegetation and trees around cut back regularly (clear a 3-foot circle).
- Paint safety yellow only (contact us for paint if needed).



Winter

- Shovel or snow blow snow around (as needed).
